

## Saddle Ranch Elementary 2019 Mustang Stampede

Dear Friends and Family,

I am a student at Saddle Ranch Elementary. SRE is a special school with small class sizes, a full range of specials, unique programming for STEAM (science, technology, engineering, arts and mathematics) and social-emotional learning, and an outstanding team of faculty and staff.

Our fall fundraiser, the Mustang Stampede, is **Tuesday, October 1st**. I will stampede through the halls of our school for a set amount of time as part of this in-school event. The Mustang Stampede promotes healthy habits and serves as one of our two major academic fundraisers.

Fundraising allows SRE's administration to keep their limited funding from the state and district focused on staffing, maintaining small class sizes, and offering a full range of specials. Money raised from past Mustang Stampedes has been used to support reading intervention programming, purchase math manipulatives, other consumable supplies, and science lab materials, purchase a new handwriting curriculum, fund teacher, classroom, and grade-level grants, help reduce the cost of Outdoor Education and more!

The PTIO's fundraising goal for the 2019-2020 school year is \$50,000 (or about \$120/student) to continue supporting these initiatives and provide funding for additional academic resources, curriculum purchases, and teacher and staff appreciation. **Our goal for the Mustang Stampede is to raise half of that: \$25,000 or \$60/student.**
